Eligibility

- Graduation Degree (Three Years) from the recognised university possessing a minimum of 55% marks or equivalent grade in aggregate in any disciplines: Sciences, Social Sciences, Commerce and Management, Arts and Humanities, Computer Sciences, and Engineering.
- Admission through CUCET 2019 (All India level Test).
- Advertisement in March and Test will take place in April/May (Look for Advertisement in www.curaj.ac.in).
- Only CUCET Score will be considered for admission.
- The CUCET Question Paper will comprise of 100 MCQs from the following discipline. i.e. English, Numerical Aptitude/Data Interpretation, Analytical Skills, Reasoning, General Aptitude, General Knowledge.

Course Design

- Course design includes: Preparatory Learning; Core-courses and Electives; ICT-based Lab Learning; Project-based Learning; Thesis and Internship.
- First Semester Courses (20 Credits): Information Technology (IT) and Society; Recent Trends in Information Technology: Internet, Web, Mobile, & Cloud Technology; Policy, Governance, and Politics in Digital Era; Research Methods in Social Sciences; ICT-Lab – Programming Concepts for Social Sciences.
- Second Semester Courses (20 Credits): Information Communication Technology Policy and Regulation; Project Management and Appraisal; Digital Media; Cyber Law; ICT-Lab-Programming Concepts for Social Sciences.
- Third Semester Courses (24 Credits): ICT & Development; Four Electives and ICT Lab (Project)
- Forth Semesters (20 Credits): Internship based Project / Thesis

Fee Structures

- The Fee Structures are determined by Central University of Rajasthan (time-to-time). As it is Government University, the fees will be much below than the fees charged by the Private University.
- The First Semester Fees of the 2019-20 for the M.Sc. in Digital Society in CURAJ: Rs. 40,000.00 (approx.) inclusive of Hostel Admission and Mess Fees.
- In case, the Students go for IIIT-Bangalore in First Semester, the fees will be as per the IIIT-B Fees Structures. The Students of First Semester M.Sc. in Digital Society (Batch 2018-20) paid approximately Rs. 78,000 to IIIT-B for the Hostel and Mess Fees (Six Months Stay in IIIT-B Campus in Electronic City, Bangalore)
