

Important Instructions regarding Entrance

Examination by DACE at CURAJ

Candidates are advised to read carefully and comply with these instructions, as also the instructions given by the Invigilator / Venue Superintendent / Supervisor at the examination centre.

1. Reporting Time: Candidates are advised to reach their examination centre at least 30 to 45 minutes prior to the reporting time and cooperate with staff during security checks. No candidate will be allowed to enter the test centre after 20 mins. of commencement of examination.
2. Candidates must bring their Photo ID Proof in original for verification purpose. Photo ID Proof may include any one of the following:
 - Aadhaar Card, Election ID Card, Pan Card, Driving Licence, Photo ID issued by University or Institution, Passport.
3. IN ABSENCE OF ORIGINAL PHOTO ID PROOF, CANDIDATES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER IN THE EXAMINATION CENTRE PREMISES.
4. Candidate must bring the printout of the Admit Card to appear in the entrance examination.
5. The candidates will not be permitted to leave the examination hall till the end of examination.
6. Electronic devices, mobile phones, smartwatches, and other related items are banned items inside the exam halls and should not be carried.
7. DACE Central University of Rajasthan will not be responsible for any loss of any items of the candidates.
8. Candidates are also advised to carry their own water bottles to stay hydrated during the exams.
9. Candidates should submit the question paper booklet and answer sheet to the invigilator before leaving the examination hall.
10. Please bring a photo copy set of documents – X, XII, Graduation, Cast Certificate, Income certificate etc.

Syllabus and Pattern of Entrance Exam

- The Entrance Exam will be based upon the syllabus of Preliminary Test of Civil Services Examination conducted by Union Public Service Commission.
- The Entrance Exam will consist of 100 Multiple Choice based questions.
- The candidates have to tick the correct answer among given four options.
- Each question will carry ONE mark each.
- No negative marking.
- Written exam will be followed by a 20 marks viva-voce. exam. Final merit will be based on marks of written and viva both.
