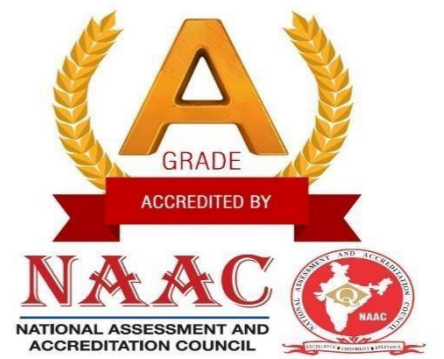

Eligibility

- Graduation Degree (Three Years) from the recognised university possessing a minimum of 55% marks or equivalent grade in aggregate in any disciplines (UR) and 50% for SC/ST/OBC/PWD/EWS candidates
- Admission through CUCET 2020 (All India level Test).
- Test will take place in May end (Look for Advertisement in www.curaj.ac.in).
- Only CUCET Score will be considered for admission.
- The CUCET Question Paper will comprise of 100 MCQs from the following discipline. i.e. English, Numerical Aptitude/Data Interpretation, Analytical Skills, Reasoning, General Aptitude, General Knowledge.

Course Design

- Courses are design to keep the students employment ready and in sync with national priorities like Digital India, Skill India, Digital Economy.
- Course design includes: Preparatory Learning; Core-courses and Electives; ICT-based Lab Learning; Project-based Learning; Thesis and Internship.
- First Semester Courses (24 Credits): Quantitative Techniques; Public Policy Paradigms and Practices; Media, Culture and Society; Economic Analysis of Public Policy; Information Technology (IT) and Society; ICT-Lab – Programming Concepts and Digital Society: Case Studies.
- Second Semester Courses (24 Credits): Information Communication Technology Policy and Regulation; Emerging Digital Technologies, Digital Media, Law and Digital Society, Project Management and Appraisal; ICT Lab-Workshop - Programming Concepts; Seminar /Term Paper/ Case Study.
- Third Semester Courses (24 Credits): Society, Networks and Social Networks; Four Electives; Data Analysis Lab R and Spatial Data Infrastructure Lab (Project)
- Forth Semesters (20 Credits): Dissertation with Internship.
- Focus of the programme is to help the student to learn the imminent digitalization process of the economy, society, polity and public policy.
