Details of the Program

M.A/M. Sc in Sports Psychology

- Objectives of the program: The 2-Years Master's Program would help to develop a career in Sports Psychology, The students would learn how the human psychology influences sports/athletic performances and the effects of exercise and physical activity on the psychology. The programme provides an insight into the theoretical and practical orientation of sports psychology and the basic skills of psychological counselling that could be applied in the context of sports coaching.
- **Duration of program:** 2 years (4 semesters)
- ► Approved Intake: 15
- Minimum Eligibility for Entry: Bachelors' Degree in any subject with Psychology as the subject or any other examination recognized equivalent there to or higher degree with 50% marks or equivalent grade in aggregate for General category and 45% or equivalent grade for SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates.
- Course Structure: Semester-wise, Core courses, Discipline Electives, Extra-Departmental Electives, Practicals/ Dissertation/Workshop.


Facilities in School of Sports Sciences

- ·Manual Stadiometer



Motion Analysis using Opensim software






