ABOUT UNIVERSITY

TEACHING LEARNING CENTRE (TLC@CURaj)

Teaching Learning Centre (TLC@CURaj) at Central University of Rajasthan was established in the year 2017-18 with a vision of support evidence based teaching and provides diverse opportunities for teachers. It is funded by MHRD, Govt. of India under the Scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNMTT). It is envisaged to help teachers to modernize their teaching style, to scaffold concepts and information in a way that students can meaningfully take in, and to help students learn more deeply and retain what they have learnt. It is also meant to train teachers about the new and effective methods of teaching. TLC will promote on a continuous basis, discipline-specific curricula, pedagogy, learning materials (including e-content) for use by the teachers in colleges and postgraduate departments. In these directions, TLC@CURaj has successfully conducted several programs in recent past like (a) Ten Days Workshop on Teaching-Learning & Evaluation for Faculty Members of HEIs; (b) Induction Training Program for Faculty Members of HEIs (c) Three Days Training Workshop on Effective Teaching/Learning Methods for Science Teachers of Schools(d) Five days workshop on Enhancing of Teaching and Learning Skills in Statistics. (e) Ten Days Refresher Course on Capacity Building program for teacher of HEIs (f) Four Weeks Induction Training Program for Faculty Members of HEIs (g) Five Days Workshop on Teaching-Learning-Eavluation For Faculty Members of HEIs (h) Five Days Workshop on Research Informed and Research Oriented Teaching in Pharmaceutical Sciences.

OBJECTIVE OF THE PROGRAMME

Outcome based Education (OBE) is a worldwide trend in Higher education that has now become a mandate for Indian Universities. It is a process of curriculum design, teaching learning methods and assessment that focuses on Learning Outcomes i.e. what students can actually do after the students in terms of their discipline specific knowledge and skills, generic competencies, attitudes and values that match the demands of the industry or the society. Learning outcome (Lo) based design of educational curriculum also helps teacher to be more efficient and effective in their delivery of courses. UGC now makes it obligatory for all Higher Educational Institutions to design and implement the LO based curriculum for various programmes. With this background this training programme is design to build the capacity of teachers that will strengthen their quality of teaching, assessment and student interaction. The workshop is also intended for understanding and implementing the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and its role in higher education.

As per gazette notification of UGC dated 18 July 2018, this workshop shall be taken into consideration for fulfilment of the requirement for the promotion of University/College teachers under the Career Advancement Scheme (CAS).
