The Council aims to review the progress of social science research and sponsor social science research programs and projects as well as administer grants to institutions and individuals for research in social sciences. The organization arranges for technical training in research methodology, provides guidance for research activities and encourages programs for interdisciplinary research. The council advises the Government of India on all matters pertaining to social science research as may be referred to from time to time and takes measures as may be necessary to promote social science research and its utilization.

- Abstracts must be submitted through the given link.
- Full names, affiliations, and emails of all authors should be included.
- Abstracts should clearly indicate research problem, methodology, and results within **250 words**.

Last date of Registration: **25th November 2024**

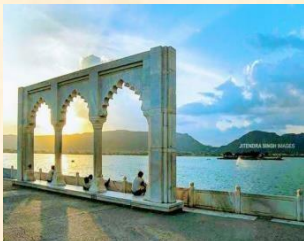
